- John Deere 4WD Tractor/Slasher with a 4.1m Slasher/Mulcher arm.
- 3 x 4-tonne Balloon Tyred Dumpers, which can all be converted to carry a 1,000 litre water tanks with pump and hose attachments, to be utilised as water carts for on or off track use.
- 5 x 5-tonne Tipper Trucks (non Road rail).
- 8 x 1-tonne Dual Cab Utility vehicles.
- Caterpillar 4WD D428 Backhoe, 4 in 1 bucket, tie handling grabs, extendable hoe and forks.
